2. What does it show me about people — and about myself?

What does this show you about desperation and faith — and about what you'd rather keep hidden?

3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

What have you been trying to get healed of quietly, without anyone knowing — and what would coming forward look like this week?

4. Who will I tell?

Who do you know who's been sick, broke, or exhausted for so long they've stopped hoping?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

★ Pray

Jesus, twelve years of trying everything is a long time. I'm reaching for You anyway — and You call me daughter.
