2. What does it show me about people — and about myself?

Jesus brings up the one subject she'd rather avoid — and she stays in the conversation. What are you steering conversations away from?

3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

Where do you keep going back for water that doesn't last — and what would asking Jesus for the living kind mean this week?

4. Who will I tell?

Who do you know who's been written off by all the respectable people?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

★ Pray

Jesus, You knew everything she'd ever done and You talked with her anyway. Talk to me like that — all of it on the table.
