3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

What is one thing God is asking of you this week where you could answer like Mary did?

4. Who will I tell?

Who could you tell this week about the girl who said yes to God's impossible news?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

Pray

Lord, Mary heard news that would change everything and answered, 'Let it be to me according to your word.' Give me the same trust when your plans interrupt mine.



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
