Is there a hard obedience God is asking of you this week?

4. Who will I tell?

Who is someone unlikely that God might want to reach through you?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

 Pray

Lord, when you call me to something hard or frightening, help me trust you and obey like Ananias did.
