4. Who will I tell?

Who could you point to God's goodness and mercy?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

✦ Pray

Lord, you are good and forgiving, abounding in love. Teach me your way, and give me an undivided heart to fear your name.
