2 Digest

1. What does this passage show me about God?

What does Mordecai ask Esther to do, and what does she risk by doing it?

2. What does it show me about people — and about myself?

For what moment might God have placed you exactly where you are right now?

3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

What risky step of obedience will you take this week, after praying like Esther fasted, trusting God with the outcome?

4. Who will I tell?

Who needs to hear that their position — job, family, city — may be God's placement for such a time as this?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

then to act.*



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
