1 Eat

2 Digest

Answer from what the passage actually says — stay in the text.

1. What does this passage show me about God?

The builders say 'let us make a name for ourselves'; what does God promise to do for Abram's name, and at what cost to Abram?

2. What does it show me about people — and about myself?

What tower are you building — career, reputation, family standing — to make your own name great?

3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

What step of trust, like Abram leaving his father's household, will you take this week on the strength of God's promise alone?

4. Who will I tell?

Who around you is wearing themselves out making a name, and how could you share what God promised Abram?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

✦ Pray

God, I confess how much of my life is spent building a name for myself so no one can look down on me. Give me instead the name you gave Abram — the one you promised, not the one I build.
