Who do you think does not deserve God's kindness? What will you pray for them this week?

4. Who will I tell?

Who thinks they are too far gone for God? What does Nineveh say to them?

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

Pray

God, a whole city said sorry and you changed your mind about destroying it. Thank you that you are that quick to forgive.
