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### 3. What will I obey this week?

*What have you stopped asking God for? Will you ask him again this week?*

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### 4. Who will I tell?

*Who has given up on praying about something? What could you say to them?*

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

## ★ Pray

*God, Abraham asked you six times and you did not once tell him to stop. Thank you that I can keep asking you too. Make me brave enough to ask you for big things.*
