3. What will I obey this week?

What is one thing God has already told you to do that you will do this week, even if it feels hard?

4. Who will I tell?

Who could you tell about a man who trusted God and went?

God, you asked Abram to go somewhere he had never seen, and he went. Thank you for going with him. Help me do what you say even when I cannot see the end of it.
