2 Digest

2. What does it show me about people — and about me?

3. What will I obey this week?

What promise will you keep this week, even a small one?

4. Who will I tell?

Who could you tell about God's promise the next time you see a rainbow?

3 Grow

★ Pray

God, thank you for a promise you will never break. When I see a rainbow, help me remember that you keep your word.
