2 Digest

1. What does this show me about God?

God gives Joshua the same promise four times: I will be with you. What does that tell you about God?

2. What does it show me about people — and about me?

God tells him to be brave because God is with him, not because Joshua is tough. What is the difference?

3. What will I obey this week?

What is one thing you are scared of this week that you will do anyway?

4. Who will I tell?

Who could you say "be strong and brave, God is with you" to this week?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).
