2. What does it show me about people — and about me?

Peter had denied Jesus three times, and Jesus asks three times. Why do you think the number matched?

3. What will I obey this week?

What have you failed at that you thought was the end? What is the next step you will take?

4. Who will I tell?

Who thinks they are finished because of what they did? What will you tell them?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

★ Pray

Jesus, you asked Peter three times if he loved you — once for every time he said he did not know you — and then you gave him work to do. Thank you that failing is not the end with you.
