Whose real need — an orphan, a widow, someone in distress — will you meet this week to put the word into practice?

4. Who will I tell?

Who could see the difference between hearing and doing in how you live this week?

God, keep me from hearing your word and walking away unchanged. Make me a doer who looks intently into your word and acts on it.
