3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

What step of obedience 'at your word' will you take this week, even if it seems pointless?

4. Who will I tell?

Who will you ask this week to study the Bible with you, letting down the net Jesus gave you?

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

★ Pray

Jesus, at your word I will let down the nets. Take my ordinary work and make me a fisher of people.
