3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

Whose home will you enter this week — for a meal or a visit — for the sake of the gospel?

4. Who will I tell?

How could a study in that house reach the whole household, not just one person?

3 Grow

Jesus, you invited yourself into Zacchaeus' house, and salvation came to his whole home. Give me courage to go into homes, because you came to seek and save the lost.



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
