3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

Move one treasure to heaven this week: give away one specific thing — a sum of money, a possession — that you have been storing up.

4. Who will I tell?

Who could you tell why you gave it away?

3 Grow

Jesus, you said my heart follows my treasure. Pry my grip off money and fix my eye on you, because I cannot serve two masters.



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
