3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

How will you trust God's way of rescue this week instead of your own?

4. Who will I tell?

Who could you invite to hear this story of the night God passed over?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

Pray

God, thank you that the blood of the lamb protected your people from death that night. Cover me and my house with your rescue.
