2 Digest

Answer from what the passage actually says — stay in the text.

1. What does this passage show me about God?

What does Jesus do when the storm rises, and what question do the disciples ask afterward?

2. What does it show me about people — and about myself?

What storm in your life makes you feel like the disciples — afraid he does not care?

3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

How will you trust Jesus in that storm this week instead of panicking?

4. Who will I tell?

Who in a storm right now could you tell about the one the wind and waves obey?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

Pray

Jesus, even the wind and the waves obey you. Speak peace over the storm I am in, and grow my faith.
