1 Eat

2 Digest

Answer from what the passage actually says — stay in the text.

1. What does this passage show me about God?

How does Paul's appeal to Caesar move him toward Rome, and what does he tell King Agrippa about his commission and his hope?

2. What does it show me about people — and about myself?

Festus called Paul crazy; Agrippa felt the pull of his words. When your faith is dismissed or half-believed, how do you respond?

3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

Paul was 'not disobedient to the vision from heaven.' What is one thing God has already made clear to you that you will finally obey this week?

4. Who will I tell?

Paul wished that everyone listening could become what he was — except for the chains. Who do you long to see follow Jesus, and what will you say to them this week?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

Pray

Jesus, you said Paul would carry your name before kings, and in chains he asked Agrippa to become what he was. Give me that same freedom — to want everyone who hears me to know you.
