2 Digest

1. What does this passage show me about God?

What do the four soils, the growing seed, and the mustard seed each show about how God's kingdom works?

2. What does it show me about people — and about myself?

Which soil best describes your heart right now — and what are the 'thorns' in your life?

3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

Jesus asks, 'Why are you so afraid?' What fear will you hand over to him this week, trusting he is in the boat?

4. Who will I tell?

A lamp is meant for the stand, not the basket. Where is your light currently hidden, and who needs to see it?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

Pray

Jesus, make my heart good soil. And when the storm rises, remind me that you are in the boat and even the wind and waves obey you.



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
