2 Digest

Answer from what the passage actually says — stay in the text.

1. What does this passage show me about God?

What does the Father say about Jesus on the mountain, and what failure are the disciples struggling with below?

2. What does it show me about people — and about myself?

'I believe; help my unbelief' — where do belief and unbelief live side by side in you right now?

3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

Jesus says whoever wants to be first must be servant of all. Who will you deliberately serve this week, expecting nothing back?

4. Who will I tell?

Who around you is 'in the valley' — struggling while others seem to be on the mountain — and how will you come alongside them?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

Pray

Lord, I believe; help my unbelief. Let me listen to your Son on the mountain and serve like the least in the valley.
