2. What does it show me about people — and about myself?

3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

Blind Bartimaeus threw off his cloak and asked plainly for mercy. What will you ask Jesus for plainly this week — and what 'cloak' must you throw off?

4. Who will I tell?

The disciples rebuked those bringing children. Who might you be unintentionally keeping from Jesus?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).

★ Pray

Jesus, you came not to be served but to serve, and to give your life as a ransom for many. Unclench my hands from what I own and what I want, and teach me your way down.



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
