2. What does it show me about people — and about myself?

3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

The women were told 'go, tell.' Having walked the whole Gospel of Mark, what is the one obedience you will carry forward from this book?

4. Who will I tell?

Who will you tell that Jesus has risen — starting this week?

3 Grow

Growth is God's part, not yours. Do the cycle faithfully and trust Him to give the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6–7).
