3. What will I obey this week? (a concrete step, with a day)

Who will you go and find this week, out where they have gone?

4. Who will I tell?

Who could you tell that God saw a foreign slave woman before he was ever called by that name?

God, a used and discarded slave woman gave you a name — the God who sees me — and you had come looking for her in the desert. See us, and make us people who see.
